Students are offered the opportunity to express a preference for either Spanish or French prior to joining us in Year 7, and we endeavour to accommodate this preference. Students then study this language throughout Years 7, 8 and 9.

Key Stage 3

At the start of Year 7 in Spanish, we utilise the language learning skills gained at primary school and apply these in Spanish lessons to enable pupils to make links and identify similarities between languages as they start learning Spanish for the first time.

In Year7, students develop the basic language skills across the four key areas of listening, speaking, reading and writing. In Years 8 and 9, they develop and build on the skills acquired to gain a good understanding of key grammatical rules, tenses and cultures where the languages are spoken; to enable them to communicate effectively.
