Founder's Day - Friday, 10th July 2015

Each year towards the end of the Summer term we have our Founder's Day celebration, which is a time of prayer, reflection and activities to acknowledge and celebrate the distinct Lasallian character of our school and the Saint on whose teachings it is founded, St Jean Baptiste de la Salle.

This year, Founder's Day will be celebrated on Friday 10th July. Students should be wearing full school uniform - unless they are competing in the sports day events, in which case they should come to school in their PE kit. **As per tradition on this day, students will be dismissed early at 1:30pm following lunch**.

Last Day of Term – Friday 17th July 2015

The school will break up for the Summer holiday on Friday 17th July. Students should be wearing full school uniform. Lessons will run as normal periods 1-3 and, after an early lunch at 11:45am and afternoon registration at 12:20pm, **they will be dismissed at the earlier time of 12:30pm**.

Parents/carers are asked to please note that in the case of early finishes, the school buses may not run at that time and there may not be a school crossing patrol.
