Dear Parents/Carers,

In summer 2015, 74% of students at Cardinal Langley achieved 5A*-C grades with 58% achieving the benchmark including English and Maths. This places us significantly above the national average and ranks us highly in many of the league tables. School Performance Tables which accurately reflect the outcomes for students at Cardinal Langley can be found at www.schoolperformancetables.org.uk

The DfE performance tables were published on 15th October and show the school figure for 5A*-C as 2%. This year 79% of students achieved A*-C in GCSE English and 97% achieved A*-C in GCSE English Literature. These results are a credit to the students and reflect the high standard of English teaching at Cardinal Langley. The Department for Education has not included either of these English qualifications in its published data. Although we have contacted them to update their figures we have not yet received a response. The Local Authority and Diocese of Salford are supporting the school and we hope that the figures will be updated soon.
