We are once again holding an awards evening to celebrate the exceptional hard work, commitment and achievements of some of our younger students and the positive contribution they make to our school community. This will take place in school from 6:00pm on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> June. Nominations are made by form tutors and subject teachers and invitations will be sent to the families of those Year 7 and Year 8 children nominated for an award.

### Open Evening - Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> June

### Inset Day - Friday 1st July

Parents/carers are reminded that there is an Inset Day in our school calendar on **Friday 1**<sup>st</sup> **July** and **the school will be closed to students on this day.** 



### Mission Week - 4th July to 8th July

Monday 4<sup>th</sup> July is the start of our Mission Week, celebrating the Pope's Jubilee Year of Mercy. This will be a week of prayer and activities, reflecting on the mercy of God and how we experience and bear witness to this in our own lives.

"Be merciful, even as your Father is merciful" (Luke 6:36).

Gee Walker will be our guest speaker; her son, Anthony, was murdered in an unprovoked, racially-motivated attack in Liverpool, aged 18. Gee will be talking to Year 9 and 10 students about how she has drawn on her Faith to be able to forgive her son's killers.

The Mercy Bus will be in school on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> July: All students will have the opportunity to receive the sacrament of reconciliation or a blessing - or simply have a chat with one of the priests on the bus.

There will be a CAFOD Activity Day aimed at Year 7 and 8 students and throughout the week there will be lessons based around the theme of mercy as well as various charity fundraising opportunities for all students.

### Founder's Day - Friday, 8<sup>th</sup> July

Mission Week culminates with Founder's Day on Friday, 8<sup>th</sup> July. This is a celebration of the distinct Lasallian character of our school and the Saint on whose teachings it is founded, St Jean Baptiste de la Salle. Mass will be celebrated in school in the morning after which students will take part in various activities throughout the day. Students should arrive at their normal school starting time and be wearing full school uniform.

As per the established tradition on this day of celebration, students will be dismissed early at 1:30pm, after lunch. If this early finish will cause you any problems, please contact the school and we will make arrangements to supervise your child until the normal finishing time.

### Harry Potter Studio Tour - Monday 11th July

We are looking forward to taking a group of students to the Warner Bros Studios near Watford, going behind the scenes of the Harry Potter films to see how they were made. If your child is due to go on the trip but hasn't received an updated letter with regards to arrangements for the day, please ask them to collect one from Mrs McKee. A small number of additional places have become available: if any student is interested, they will need to see their English teacher for further details. The school will break up for the Summer holiday on Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> July 2016. Students should be wearing full school uniform. Lessons will run as normal periods 1-3 and, after an early lunch and afternoon registration, they will be dismissed at the earlier time of 12:30pm.

Parents/carers are asked to please note that when there is an early finish the school buses may not run and there may not be a school crossing patrol.

### **Student Lockers**

Students will need to make sure that they empty their locker and remove any padlocks before they leave on the last day of term - otherwise, padlocks will have to be cut off by the caretakers. Any personal belongings left behind over the Summer will be kept for two weeks in September, after which they will be given to charity shops. Lockers will be re-allocated in September by Mrs Fisher in Student Services.

### **Summer Holiday Activity Club**

Cardinal Langley is once again running a sports and activity club over the Summer holiday with activities suitable for children from Reception class up to age 13. ### **School Meals**

The cost of a standard school meal is likely to increase to £2.05 from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2016.

Many children in the UK are entitled to free school meals but often parents are not aware that they are eligible or they choose not to claim their entitlement. We would like to encourage parents and carers to apply for free school meals for their child for two main reasons:

Your child can select a good-quality, healthy lunch each school day using their personal catering account, the same as other students and staff do.

The school can claim Pupil Premium funding for every child receiving their free school meal entitlement. This additional funding helps us to provide a wider range of opportunities and learning experiences for your child.

### **School Uniform**

Once again, we would like to thank parents and carers for their support in ensuring that students come to school in full school uniform. May we remind students that:

Trainers, boots and canvas shoes are not allowed as footwear; shoes displaying a designer brand
or logo are also against policy. Examples of acceptable school footwear can be found on the
school website.

- The only items of jewellery allowed are a watch and a single, plain, 'gold' or 'silver' stud in the lobe of the ear.
- Nail varnish, false nails, false eyelashes and make-up are not allowed.
- Hairstyles should be tidy, no shorter than a number 2 and of one, natural colour and not dyed.

Students who do not comply with the uniform rules will face a consequence, which may include removal/confiscation of the items and/or an internal exclusion.

### Staying Safe over the Summer Holiday

Please might we take this opportunity to ask parents and carers to remind their children about staying safe over the Summer holiday, especially on the roads and when out and about near water and other potential hazards such as railways, level crossings and building sites.
