### **Important Notes**

- 1. Photographs <u>MUST</u> measure 150mm wide x 105mm deep (landscape format) in order to fit in with the design of the calendar.
- 2. Photographs with the date and time or a logo printed over the image will be discounted by the judging panel.
- 3. To protect the privacy of people, photographs with images of recognisable people cannot be accepted.
- 4. The scene and location of the photograph together with the name & address of the applicant <u>MUST</u> be clearly written on the reverse of each print if non-digital photographs are to be submitted, BUT only lightly so it does not impact on the photographic image.
- 5. Photograph locations <u>MUST</u> be in Middleton, Heywood, Whitworth, Milnrow, Newhey, Wardle, Littleborough, Norden or Rochdale.

## **Hints & Tips from Springy the Frog**

Our panel will be looking for photographs that:

- Reflect the four seasons
- Cover scenes in all parts of the Borough
- Preferably capture a special scene or local event
- We get lots of Winter photographs; don't forget Summer, Autumn and Spring!
- A good photograph can be spoilt by the scene not being properly framed often we see good shots spoilt by distracting items in the background such as passing vehicles, advertisement signs, inquisitive people and the like!
- Photographs showing local events in recognisable locations seem to attract the judging panel's eye. Think of sporting events of all kinds, seasonal and religious festivals, civic ceremonies, and other entertainments.
- When photographing familiar locations i.e. the Town Hall and Hollingworth Lake why
  not take a less obvious approach. Perhaps a different point of view or angle.
- Make sure your photographs primarily illustrate a great recognisable location rather than say, animals in an anonymous field.
