Re: COVID Roadmap

The Government announcement to postpone moving to step 4 of the national roadmap had been widely reported in the press and did not come as a surprise. This means that the current level of school restrictions will remain in place and we will not be easing our restrictions from next week as originally planned. It also means that our summer term Year 5/6 Open Evening will be postponed and will now take place on Thursday 30th September.

There are currently a low number of cases in our school community and we all need to work together to ensure this continues. Regular testing is a key strategy in identifying and isolating cases to prevent the spread and of the virus and we are all encouraged to complete the twice weekly testing programme and report our results online. Regular hand washing and wearing of face coverings in corridors and communal areas are also important steps that we can take. Please stress the importance of these measures with your son / daughter.

Due to the spread of the Delta Covid-19 Variant, Greater Manchester is an Enhanced Response Area. This means that wherever possible, people should try to:

- Meet outside rather than inside
- Keep 2 metres from people that you do not live with, including family and friends who are not part of your household
- minimise travel in and out of affected areas

You should also:

- Get tested twice a week for free and isolate if the test comes back positive
- Continue to work from home if you can
- Get vaccinated when you are offered it

As a school, we are working closely with local Public Health and continue to place the safety of all in our community as our highest priority. We will continue to regularly review our risk assessment and I will keep you updated of any changes that are necessary.
