Dear Parent / Carer

Re: Consenting for the first and second dose of the Covid-19 vaccination

I am writing to inform you that the NHS we will be offering the second dose of the Covid-19 vaccination in school on **Friday 28th January**. Children who missed the opportunity to have their first dose of the vaccine will also be offered. This is in addition to the vaccine clinics being held at Hopwood Medical Centre. The team will only immunise children with a completed Covid-19 vaccination consent form from a parent or carer with parental responsibility.

If you wish to give your consent for your child to receive their first or second dose of the Covid-19 vaccine, please return the consent form that has been given to your child.

Consent forms must be returned to school by Wednesday 26th January.

Your child's second dose will be from 12 weeks after they had their first dose. If your child has tested positive for Covid-19 they need to wait 12 weeks before they can have their vaccine - this starts from the date of their positive test.

The programme will be delivered by the NHS who also administer the other immunisation programmes for young people.

Schools have been asked to provide a venue for the vaccine to be administered and assist with the communication with students and parents. If you have previously filled in a consent form for your child to receive the Covid-19 vaccine you must complete a new consent form for vaccinations next week.

Without the correct consent form your child will not be vaccinated.
