Year 11

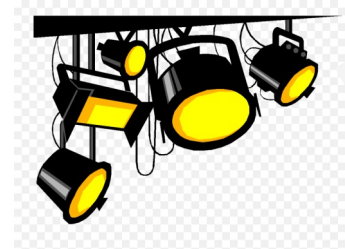
Students take part in workshops where they apply the practitioner techniques to their own practical work. Students undertake research and keep a written logbook.
