There were many happy faces this morning, as teachers and support staff congratulated everybody, acknowledging not simply their academic successes, but also their wider achievements such as the Duke of Edinburgh award, charity fundraising and community outreach work that have made the last two years very memorable for everyone involved. This year, students' average UCAS point score increased once more and 42% of students achieved grades A* - B at A-level with 68% of BTEC grades being Distinction Star or Distinction.
